

## Tasmanian State Migration Plan - Occupation List FY2013/2014

### Important information for applicants

The Tasmanian State Migration Plan (SMP) - Occupation List has been compiled by the Department of Economic Development, Tourism and the Arts (DEDTA). To be considered for state visa sponsorship, applicants must meet Tasmanian sponsorship eligibility requirements as well as the visa requirements outlined by the Department of Immigration and Boarder Protection (DIBP). For information on state sponsorship, please carefully read the eligibility requirement PDF sheets.

Tasmanian graduates who meet the visa requirements outlined by DIBP as well as the Tasmanian eligibility requirements do not need to have their nominated occupation on the Tasmanian SMP list. 'Tasmanian graduates' are those who studied at a Tasmanian educational institution for at least two years in their mainstream course and successfully completed their qualification. When applicants with non-SMP occupations are sponsored; they will be counted toward the 100 spaces allocated to Tasmania for 'off-list nominations' in the fiscal year 2013/14. When the 100 spaces are filled, such off-list nominations will cease.

If you are not a Tasmanian graduate you should have an occupation on the Tasmanian SMP list AND require either a job offer, strong interest from Tasmanian employer(s) or substantial and current links to Tasmania. In other words, applicants who have not secured either are not eligible to apply.

A 'Job offer' must be genuine and be presented in writing, in the form of job offer letter and/or employment contract. Commencement of employment must be discussed and agreed between the two parties. DEDTA may directly check with the employer regarding the genuine need and the capacity to employ the applicant. If it is a new business, the business must have been operating for more than 6 months. Details of the job offer will be assessed based on the RSMS guidelines (i.e. legally operating in the state, genuine need for the position, financial resources etc).

'Strong interest' means that an employer has examined the applicant's qualification, skill set, work experience and English language proficiency, and has confirmed that the applicant is highly employable within their business and there is a reasonable prospect for an available vacancy upon arrival to Tasmania. (The business must have been operating for more than 6 months and have demonstrated financial resources to cover employment costs. The prospects/capacity to have future vacancies will also be checked.) The employer may also wish to address recruitment difficulties for the profession. Generic comments from employment agencies will not be accepted as strong interest, and an employer simply expressing an intention to interview is not sufficient enough to be considered as strong interest.

Examples of 'substantial and current links to Tasmania' include study and/or employment within the state for a period greater than 12 months, having lived in Tasmania for more than 12 of the past 24 months, having relatives who have settled in Tasmania and who are willing to assist with relocation and settlement. Short holidays to the state are not considered to be links to Tasmania.

The occupations on this list do not represent specific vacancies nor any promise of a job. Should you be granted a state sponsored visa and settle in Tasmania, it is your responsibility to secure employment. Please note that migrants receive no 'special treatment' and you will have to compete with local candidates for available jobs.
